Dear Ms. Dortch:

On behalf of The Curators of the University of Missouri, the licensee of noncommercial educational FM Station KMNR, Rolla, Missouri ("KMNR"), this is to request special temporary authority for the station to continue operating at low power of 30 kW. As the FCC was previously notified, the station has experienced transmitter problems. The station is waiting to hear from the manufacturer concerning necessary repairs. At this time the station does not know just when repairs will be completed and full operation restored.

Accordingly, for the foregoing reasons, KMNR respectfully requests special temporary authority to operate at 30 kW.

KMNR is a noncommercial educational FM station and therefore no fee is required for this request. An Anti-Drug Certification is attached.
